## Jan - Dec 2021

Over Founded by Lt Gen Ghulam Muhammad Malik (Retd) Al Mustafa Trust made a humble start on 5th Sep 1998 housed in a View small building provided by a Philanthropist free of any rent. Ever since, the Trust has moved a long way making an unparalleled progress, now having 24 medical centres (8 urban, 16 rural), 16 dispensaries including 9 mobile units. (visiting 59 locations twice a week) thus providing free primary health care facilities in 99 cities, towns and villages across the Country. The number of beneficiaries during 2021 stands at 1,057,107 as against 816,591in the year 2020, an increase of 29%. Glancing through history of our performance would reveal enhanced figures of beneficiaries every year indicating the trust reposed in our operations and functioning. Despite closure of OPDs in public and private health care sector and effects of Coronavirus, our medical centres (barring few) remained functional throughout and kept on providing much needed medical care to the poor and the needy across the Country. Some of our medical centres have been designated as vaccination centres also.

Overseas Pakistani Doctors funding our dispensaries/mobile clinics at Dina, Toba Tek Singh and Piplan have confidence in our ability to serve the poor and the needy. Besides registration with Pakistan Centre for Philanthropy (PCP), The Trust is also registered with UK Charity Commission

and the state of Virginia, USA.

# Performance under Covid-19 Environment

Our centres and dispensaries remained fully functional during Covid which proved to be a blessing for the poor patients as the OPDs of Govt/private hospitals remained suspended for quite some time. Our centres at Karachi, however had to be closed for a short duration under lock down policy by the Sindh Govt.

#### Covid Vaccination

Most of the medical setups of the Trust were designated as Vaccination Centre for Covid by NCOC, hence we facilitated and contributed to Govt's drive to reach out to people for vaccination. During 2021, over 100,000 individuals benefited from our medical facilities and got vaccinated.

### Medical Camps

In addition to provision of routine medical services, our centres also frequently arrange medical and eye camps at various locations in their respective areas, hence during the year 2021 also these camps were organized at Kanyat Khalil (Gujar Khan), Danda Shah Bilawal (Chakwal), Chawali (Chakwal), ChakSada (Gujrat), New Dhokri (Khushab), Rera (Bagh-AK), Sohawa Dewalian (Chakwal), Barh (Kohat) and Chak 16/14-L Iqbal Nagar (Sahiwal). Alarge number of patients were given treatment at their door steps.

#### Additional activities

By virtue of our policy to reach out to poor and the needy in remote areas, and at times on request by our worthy donors, Al Mustafa Trust also facilitates them in their humanitarian pursuits. Thus, distribution of rations to the destitute families was done at our medical centres Sillanwali (Sargodha), Korangi (Karachi) and Rera (Bagh-AK). Similarly, some cash and soaps were also distributed at Main Medical Center Chaklala and Chak Sada while warm clothings were distributed by Rera (Bagh-AK).











## Computerization

The process of computerization of our medical centers is in progress. Up till now we are operational in Korangi, Mehmoodabad, Clifton, Mehran Town and Orangi centres of Karachi in Southern Region, Walton, Qila Gujar Singh, DHA Lahore and Sillanwali in the Centre; Chaklala and Lalazar in the North. While the daily functioning of medical centres has been computerized, We have also started to use financial module and developed donation module through which fund-raising events and donations have been electronically documented in real time at Rawalpindi and Karachi.

## CONCLUSION

The activities indicated in preceding paras would reveal that the canvas of our operational performance has enlarged manifold with our 99 footprints spread across the country. Besides medical centres the plan to establish dispensaries and mobile clinics have enabled us to reach out to maximum number of people of lower strata of our society, hence exceeding number of beneficiaries every year. The untiring effort of the Board of Management and avid support of our donors, trustees and friends is the hallmark of our success. In all humility we bow before Almighty Allah to grant us the strength and resolve that we continue to fulfill our mission to serve humanity to the best of our abilities.
